## A RESOLUTION OF HANOVER TWONSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, SUPPORTING THE CITY OF BETHLEHEM'S PA SMALL WATER AND SEWER PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION

Be it RESOLVED, that Hanover Township of Northampton County does hereby support the City of Bethlehem's request for a PA Small Water and Sewer Program grant of \$85,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for replacement of a 260 foot section of sanitary sewer main on Biafore Avenue in Hanover Township.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that Hanover Township does hereby confirm ownership of said sanitary sewer main and has entered into an inter-municipal agreement with the City of Bethlehem whereby the City has agreed to operate and maintain Township's system including replacement of sewer lines and appurtenances.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that Hanover Township does hereby confirm and agree that the City of Bethlehem will designate appropriate officials to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Bethlehem and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
