RE-ORGANIZATION MEETING January 4, 2010

The annual re-organization meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Hanover Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, was called to order at the Township Municipal Building, 3630 Jacksonville Road, Bethlehem, Pennsylvania 18017, at 7:30 P.M. by the presiding Chairman, Mr. John N. Diacogiannis.

Present were Supervisors Diacogiannis, Nagle, Tanczos, and Walbert.

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Mr. Diacogiannis noted for the record that prior to the meeting Supervisors Tanczos & Walbert, Robert Van Why - Fire Marshal, Michael Podhany, Assistant Fore Marshall, John J. Finnigan, Jr. – Tax Collector and Michael J. Prendeville – Auditor took their oath of office from the Honorable Emil Giordano, Court of Common Pleas – Northampton County.

The first order of business is to organize the Board of Supervisors.

Upon a motion of Mr. Nagle, seconded by Mr. Tanczos, the Board unanimously approved to re-appoint John N. Diacogiannis as Chairman of the Board of Supervisors for the year 2010.

Mr. Diacogiannis thanked the Board for their confidence and support.

Upon a motion of Mr. Nagle, seconded by Mr. Tanczos, the Board unanimously approved to re-appoint Glenn R. Walbert as Vice-Chairman of the Board of Supervisors for the year 2009.

Upon a motion of Mr. Nagle, seconded by Mr. Tanczos, the Board unanimously approved to re-appoint Mr. James Broughal, Esq. representing the Law Firm of Broughal & DeVito, L.L.P., as Township Solicitor for the year 2010 at the rate of \$110.00 per hour as stated in his letter dated October 22, 2009, a copy of which is attached and made part of the minutes, for all work as well as \$110.00 per hour for the attendance at any meeting. The fee of \$110.00 per hour for meetings is extended to an associate of the Broughal & DeVito, L.L.P. in the absence of Mr. Broughal.

All other time spent by Mr. Birdsall or an associate of Hanover Engineering on Township matters shall be noted by assigned work orders and work order numbers and charged at rates set forth in the 2010 fee schedule, submitted by Mr. Birdsall with his cover letter dated September 2, 2009, a copy of which is attached and made part of the minutes.

WHEREAS, for the collection of Township Taxes, the tax collector shall be allowed by the taxing authorities, needful expenditures for printing, postage, books, blanks and forms; and

WHEREAS, Section 36.1 of the same act further provides that the taxing authorities set the compensation for the office of tax collector.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED on this day that compensation for the office of tax collector of Hanover Township, Northampton County, be fixed at the rate of fifty (\$50.00) for the fiscal year 2010, and be it further

RESOLVED that the Township shall make payment or otherwise provide for printing, postage, books, blanks and forms as required in the duties of this office.

RESOLUTION 10-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HANOVER TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING, EMPOWERING AND DIRECTING THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BERKHEIMER WHEREUNDER BERKHEIMER IS APPOINTED AS THE TAX COLLECTOR FOR THE COLLECTION OF REAL ESTATE TAXES FOR THE TERM HEREIN DEFINED, TOGETHER WITH SUCH EXTENSIONS AS MAY BE AGREED UPON, SAID TAX ENACTMENT HAVING BEEN ADOPTED UNDER AND PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE PENNSYLVANIA LOCAL TAX COLLECTION LAW.

WHEREAS, 72 P.S. §5453.201 allows for the imposition of a tax upon real estate; and

WHEREAS, Hanover Township, Northampton County, by Resolution and/or Ordinance, has levied, assessed and provided for the collection of such Real Estate Tax; and

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the Local Tax Collection Law, 72 P.S. §5511.22, allows Hanover Township, Northampton County and its tax collector to appoint in writing one or more tax collectors to receive and collect taxes in a like manner and with like authority as the tax collector appointing them; and

WHEREAS, Hanover Township, Northampton County, and Berkheimer have negotiated an Agreement whereby and whereunder it has hired Berkheimer as a deputy tax collector to collect taxes for Hanover Township, Northampton County,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. HANOVER TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY hereby appoints BERKHEIMER as its Deputy Tax Collector of its REAL ESTATE TAX for the initial term commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2010, and any subsequent renewal terms thereafter. This appointment resolution shall be deemed to encompass any renewal terms agreed upon by the parties without further reenactment of this resolution or reappointment.
- 2. Further, HANOVER TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY APPROVES AND ADOPTS the Agreement negotiated with Berkheimer for the collection of the REAL

ESTATE TAX.

3. Any resolution or part of this resolution conflicting with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
