TRADITIONS OF AMERICA AT BRIDLE PATH – PHASE IV Lewis Rauch (Lehigh Engineering)

Planners reviewed this final phase for this development.

Plan eliminates Olde Glory Lane and the boulevard layout at the western end of Resolution Drive. Units 154 through 158 are relocated. The revised amount of proposed impervious coverage is now 37 ½% maximum.

54 units are proposed. The total number of units in this Adult Community Development is 204.

Building footprint for proposed Community Center has been slightly revised. This change must be shown on the Phase I Record Plan.

Improvements to the Jacksonville/Bridle Path Road intersection have been completed. 27" pipes beneath Jacksonville Road will control the rate of water.

Motion was made by Vail, seconded by Lawless, to send a letter to the Board of Supervisors recommending approval of the Traditions of America at Bridle Path, Phase IV, Land Development Record Plan for the reasons set forth by the Applicant and referencing letter from Hanover Engineering Associates dated May 29, 2014, also with the Applicant's agreement to comply with requirements therein.

Planning recommends approval of the Applicant's requested Phase IV waivers/deferrals for the reasons set forth by the Applicant and as previously addressed by the Planning Commission and approved by the Board of Supervisors for Phase I, II and III.
