RE-ORGANIZATION MEETING January 2, 2018

The annual re-organization meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Hanover Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, was called to order at the Township Municipal Building, 3630 Jacksonville Road, Bethlehem, PA 18017, at 7:00 P.M. by the presiding Chairman, Mr. John N. Diacogiannis.

Mr. Diacogiannis welcomed Supervisor Lawless to the Board.

Present were Supervisors Diacogiannis, Prendeville, Salvesen, Nagle and Lawless.

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Mr. Diacogiannis noted that at 6:30 p.m. the Hon. Emil Giordano, Northampton County Court of Common Pleas administered the Oath of Office to Supervisors Susan A. Lawless & John D. Nagle, Tax Collector John J. Finnigan, Jr., Auditor Mark J. Tanczos, Zoning Hearing Board member Brian A. Dillman; and Planning Commission members Gordon M. Campbell & Richard L. Kanaskie.

The next order of business is to reorganize the Board of Supervisors.

Upon a motion of **Mr. Nagle**, seconded by **Mr. Prendeville**, the Board approved to reappoint John N. Diacogiannis Chairman of the Board of Supervisors for the year 2018. Mr. Salvesen – aye, Mr. Nagle – aye, Ms. Lawless – aye, Mr. Prendeville - aye, Mr. Diacogiannis, abstain.

Mr. Diacogiannis thanked the Board for their confidence and support.

Upon a motion of **Mr. Nagle**, seconded by **Mr. Salvesen**, the Board unanimously approved to appoint Michael J. Prendeville Vice-Chairman of the Board of Supervisors for the year 2018.

Mr. Salvesen – aye, Mr. Nagle – aye, Ms. Lawless – yes, Mr. Prendeville - abstain, Mr. Diacogiannis, aye.

Mr. Prendeville also thanked the Board for their confidence and support.

Mr. Nagle then moved to move the agenda and that an **aye** vote be recorded for each board member on all motions except where to do so would constitute a conflict of interest. **Mr. Salvesen** seconded the motion. Mr. Diacogiannis asked if any member wanted to discuss or vote on any motion individually. Without that request, Mr. Diacogiannis called for a roll call vote on the motion.

Mr. Finnigan thanked the Board and staff for their support in 2017 and is looking forward to working with everyone again in 2018. He also welcomed Ms. Lawless to the Board and congratulated Mr. Diacogiannis and Mr. Prendeville.

All other time spent by Mr. Kocher or an associate of Hanover Engineering on Township matters shall be noted by assigned work orders and work order numbers and charged at rates set forth in the 2018 fee schedule, submitted by Mr. Brien R. Kocher, PE with his cover letter dated September 13, 2017, a copy of which is attached and made part of the minutes.

WHEREAS, for the collection of Township Taxes, the tax collector shall be allowed by the taxing authorities, needful expenditures for printing, postage, books, blanks and forms; and

WHEREAS, Section 36.1 of the same act further provides that the taxing authorities set the compensation for the office of tax collector.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED on this day that compensation for the office of tax collector of Hanover Township, Northampton County, be fixed at the rate of seventy-five (\$75.00) for the fiscal year 2018 and be it further

RESOLVED that the Township shall make payment or otherwise provide for printing, postage, books, blanks and forms as required in the duties of this office.
